

## Cost of Attendance (COA)

A survey of all students was conducted during April 2016 to determine the average costs for room, board, books and supplies, travel, child care and miscellaneous expenses. The results of the survey are available in the Office of the Director of Financial Aid. Based upon the results of the survey an average cost for the specific items mentioned was calculated. Every subsequent year, the COA will for costs other than tuition will be revised based upon the Cost of Living for the previous year. Actual tuition costs and licensing fees for 2nd year students will be included in the final calculation. Those students incurring exceptional costs in particular areas, may request the Director of Financial Aid to have their COA adjusted to reflect those costs, based upon a written request and presenting proper documentation.
