Job Placement for Graduates by Program
for the reporting period of 7/1/14 – 6/30/15

Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program

Graduates are employed as ultrasound technologists in hospitals, medical centers, imaging centers, mobile companies and private physician practices.

Radiography Program

Graduates are employed as radiologic technologists in hospitals, medical centers, imaging centers and private physician practices.

Radiation Therapy Program

Graduates are employed as radiation therapists in hospitals, medical centers and private clinics.

EMS/Paramedic Program

Graduates are employed as paramedics with ambulance companies, in hospitals, fire departments and medical centers.

Medical Assistant Program

There were no graduates during this time frame. The program was launched in July 2015 and the first class is scheduled to graduate in May 2016.

Surgical Technology Program

There were no graduates during this time frame. The program was launched in September 2015 and the first class is scheduled to graduate in August 2016.

How Job Placement Rates Are Calculated

To be counted as placed, a graduate must be verified as employed for a minimum of 15 days. The placement rate is determined by using the ABHES required method of calculation as follows:

Placement Rate = (F + R)/(G-U)

F = Graduates placed in their field of training

R* = Graduates placed in a *related* field of training

G = Total graduates

U** = Graduates unavailable for placement

*Related field refers to a position wherein the majority of the graduate's job functions require the use of skills and knowledge acquired through successful completion of the training program.

**Unavailable is defined only as documented: health-related issues, military obligations, incarceration, continuing education status, or death.
