

PRACTICAL NURSING INAUGURAL COHORT SCHOLARSHIP

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

To receive and maintain the PN Scholarship, students must:

- Complete all CAHE Admissions requirements.
- Complete the 2026–2027 FAFSA and any additional required financial aid documents.
- Be a high school graduate or have a GED or recognized equivalent.
- Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- Remain in good academic standing and meet all applicable SAP requirements.
- Complete all requirements necessary to receive federal financial aid once the PN program becomes eligible.
- Accept all federal student aid for which they are eligible and that CAHE is permitted to award, including applicable federal grants and federal student loans.

Students are not required to apply for or accept private financing to receive the scholarship.

BEFORE FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID IS AVAILABLE

While CAHE awaits federal financial aid approval for the PN program, CAHE will provide an internal PN Scholarship to eligible students so that tuition responsibility does not exceed \$2,000 per quarter. Depending on the student's circumstances, the amount may be less.

ONCE FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID BECOMES AVAILABLE

Eligible federal and/or state financial aid will be applied to the student's account, including for prior quarters when permitted. If CAHE previously awarded a PN Scholarship for that quarter, CAHE will adjust the scholarship to reflect the newly available aid. Regardless of that adjustment, the student's tuition responsibility will still not exceed \$2,000 for that quarter. If aid and other assistance reduce the responsibility below \$2,000, the student will pay the lower amount.

IMPORTANT REQUIREMENT

To continue receiving the PN Scholarship after federal financial aid becomes available, students must complete all required financial aid steps and accept the federal aid for which they are eligible and that CAHE is permitted to award. Students who decline available federal aid may no longer qualify for the PN Scholarship and may become responsible for additional tuition charges. Students are not required to apply for or accept private financing.

PROGRAM FEES WAIVED

As a separate benefit, CAHE will waive applicable program fees for students in the inaugural PN cohort. The fee waiver is separate from the PN Scholarship and is not connected to federal or state financial aid eligibility, approval, or the amount of aid a student receives. The fee waiver will not be reduced, replaced, or removed if financial aid later becomes available. This special fee waiver applies to the inaugural cohort and should not be assumed to apply to future PN cohorts.
